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The Island

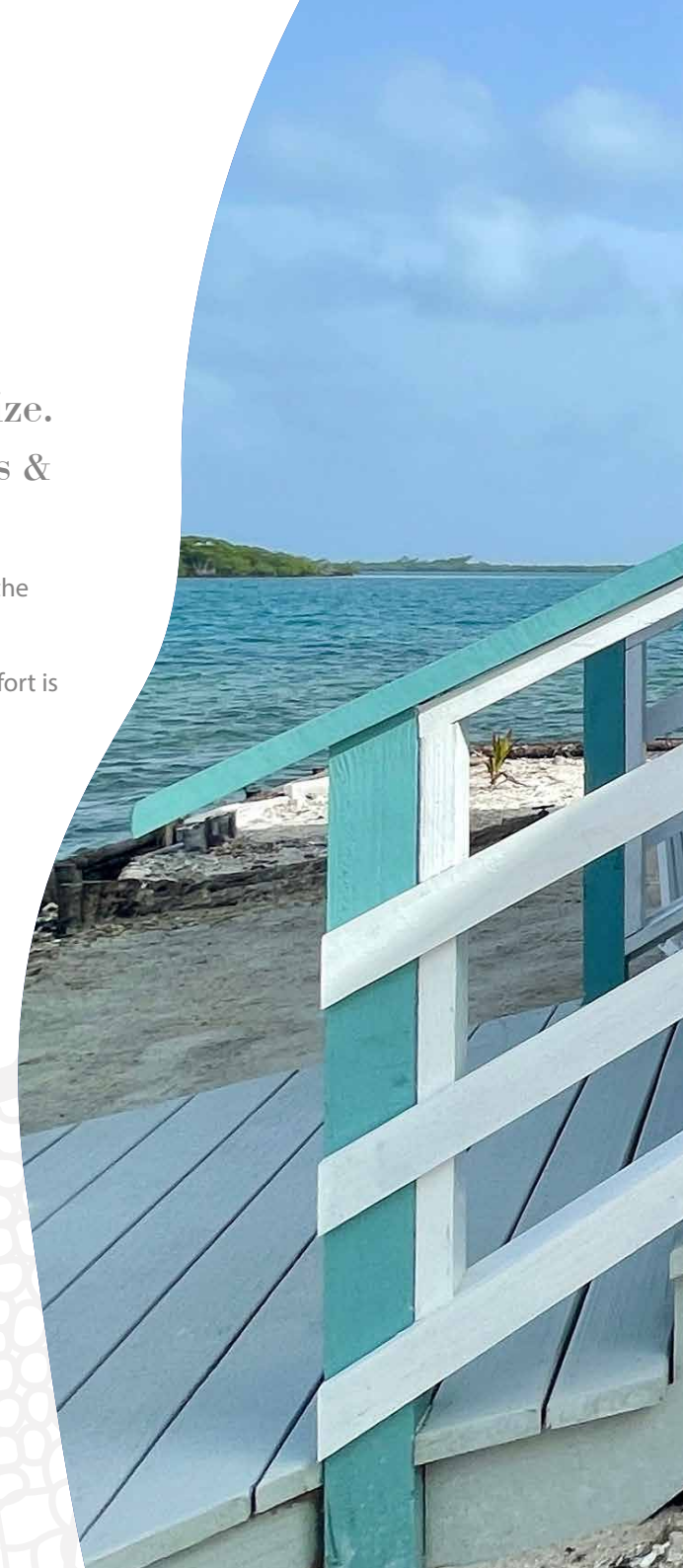
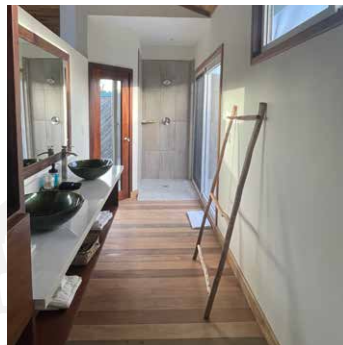

Based on a Caribbean island situated on the Belize Barrier Reef where there are barely other boats, this is a fisherman or diver's dream! Here you'll have the chance to fish alongside some of Belize's finest fisherman. Fish on the shelf for the big Wahoo, Dorado, Tuna, Barracuda's and Kingfish. Bottom fish for the huge Snappers, Groupers and Jacks. Fly fish the surrounding flats for Bonefish, Permits and Tarpon, there's something for everyone.

Spend a day on the mainland visiting Mayan ruins, caves, zip lining, repelling, horseback riding, waterfalls or souvenir shop for the day.



Fishing

One the biggest benefits is the variety of fish. Our focus is on maintaining sustainable practices, only non-threatened species will be consumed on the island.

Nothing will go to market and if the fish is not sustainable, we will catch and release only. Catch a delicious seafood dinner, then give yourself a break and go for a dive or snorkel!

Billfish Blue Water (upgrades available)

We are the only deep-water fishing operator in the area. Blue Reef Island gives you the chance to fish the blue water for large pelagic species, such as Marlin, Sailfish, Sharks, Tuna, Dorado and Wahoo.

Scuba Diving & Snorkeling

Explore areas in and around South Water Caye Marine Reserve, the largest marine reserve in Belize, spanning from just north of Tobacco Caye to a cut five miles south of South Water Caye called Grand Channel.

We welcome divers of all levels. Help us rid the invasive lionfish by scuba or free diving with a spear! Or, free dive for your lobster and/or conch dinner! (Seasonal).

With literally dozens of dive sites, Blue Reef dive guides will show you a variety of species and topography. There are fewer divers at this pristine southern section of the barrier reef. Typically, the sites are wall dives that are interspersed with spur and groove sections and sand channels.

On our dive trips we often see eagle rays, turtles, moray eels, barracuda, king mackerel, and southern stingrays. Our divers have spotted manta rays, hammerhead sharks, reef sharks and dolphins. We often find new dive sites and it's fun for our guests to name the sites.

Want to help us with our lionfish spearing project? It is a ton of fun hunting and spearing the invasive lionfish, and we help the environment at the same time! Lionfish tastes delicious, and our chef will prepare your catch at the end of the day.

Snorkeling

Snorkel with turtles, nurse sharks, eagle rays, sting rays and a huge abundance of colorful tropical fish. And, if you are really lucky you may get a change to swim with a Whale shark.

Upon arrival into Dangriga, a shuttle will be arranged to will take you to the boat.

We provide fishing gear and diving equipment.

Diving insurance is mandatory, but not included in the trip package.

Most travel insurance policies can provide dive insurance for dives down to 100 feet (30 meters).

Divers Alert Network; offers comprehensive dive insurance packages at reasonable rates and is a popular choice amongst divers.

Please bring a copy of your insurance documents with you for Blue Reef Island to file.

Getting to Blue Reef Island

Belize International Airport BZE (Phillip Goldson) is only a short hop from the United States with flights taking as little as 2 1/2 hours. To search for flights at very reasonable prices, check out Kayak or Skyscanner.

The major airlines servicing Belize out of the United States are American Airlines, Southwest Airlines, Continental Airlines, United airlines, TACA airlines, Delta and US Air.

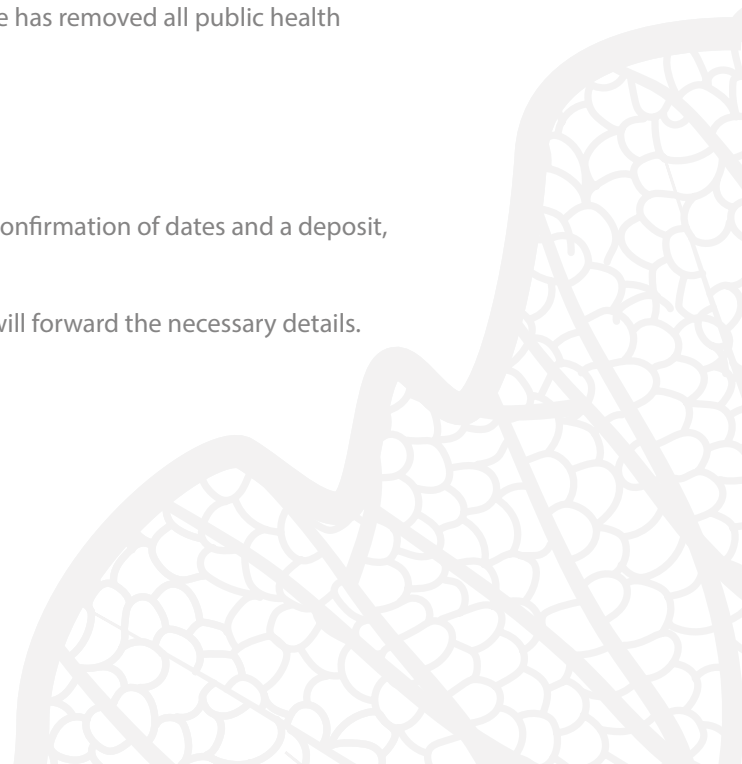
From Belize City you can fly down to Dangriga or hire a car. If you choose to fly, Blue Reef Adventures can reserve the flights for you. The flight takes 15 mins, costs US\$165.00 round trip per person and is an exciting ride. Have your camera ready as you fly low enough to take in all the beautiful scenery with the jungle on one side and the reef on the other. For groups, you can hire a mini-van and drive the 3-hour drive to Dangriga.

Please check out the Government website link for the latest COVID-19 entry requirements. The Government of Belize has removed all public health measures at the points of entry into Belize. There are no COVID negative test or proof of vaccination requirements.

Planning Your Trip

We only take small groups, so in order to secure a place it is advisable to contact us as soon as possible. We require confirmation of dates and a deposit, with the remainder of the balance due 60 days prior to arrival.

We do take credit cards. We also have bank accounts in the US, so; if you prefer to pay via check or wire transfer we will forward the necessary details.









Cancellation Policies

Deposits are non-refundable but are transferable.

If you cancel your trip 60 days or more prior to departure, 50% of the balance is non-refundable. If you cancel within 60 days the entire balance is non-refundable.

If Blue Reef cancels the trip prior to departure, 100% of the balance and the deposit are refundable, except in cases of natural disaster and force majeure.

Force Majeure

Blue Reef Caribbean Island Resorts Ltd (BRCR) will not be liable for failure to perform agreed obligations, if such failure is as a result of Acts of God (including fire, flood, earthquake, storm, hurricane or other natural disaster), Virus's such as COVID-19, war, invasion, act of foreign enemies, hostilities (regardless of whether war is declared), civil war, rebellion, revolution, insurrection, military or usurped power or confiscation, terrorist activities, nationalization, government sanction, blockage, embargo, labor dispute, strike, lockout or interruption or failure of electricity or telephone service.

Should diving, fishing or island transfers not take place due to force majeure, natural disaster or unforeseeable circumstances including rough sea conditions, monies will not be refunded.
